Letter from the Pastor

This 4th of July our nation celebrated 244 years of independence. As American citizens, independence has come with a great number of freedoms, including the ability to gather and worship without fear or threat from the government. I'm thankful for this freedom and the lack of persecution that I face as a Christian in western Oklahoma. I recognize that this is not everyone's story.

Let me introduce you to Jean-Paul Sankagui. In 1993, Jean-Paul planted a church in the Muslim neighborhood of Ramandji, on the outskirts of Bangui located in the Central African Republic. As a nation, the Central African Republic is approximately 50% Christian. Pastor Jean-Paul was well known for his faithful Christian witness. Determined to eradicate Christians, radical Islamists shot and killed Pastor Jean-Paul Sankagui on Feb. 7, 2017 and then proceeded to loot and burn his home. He is survived by his wife of 48 years, 11 children and 17 grandchildren.

According to church tradition, June 29 is the date on which the Apostle Paul was beheaded on the Appian Way in Rome. June 29 has grown into an annual day of remembrance called the Day of the Christian Martyr, when Christians around the world honor the legacy of those who, like the Apostle Paul, sacrificed their lives for the advancement of the gospel.

This year, in conjunction with the Day of the Christian Martyr, Jean-Paul's story is being told and his name is being added to the Martyrs Memorial at the Voice of the Martyrs headquarters in Bartlesville, OK.

Jean-Paul's story and those like it are important. They remind us that the freedoms we experience as American citizens are indeed a blessing, but the joy of knowing God and sharing the freedom found in His love is even more important. "...But whoever loses their life for me and for the gospel will save it." Mark 8:35.

May we be bold witnesses for Christ to a nation in need of saving.
