Ten years ago, the self-proclaimed Islamic State (ISIS) began marking Christian homes and churches with the Arabic letter "n," ن as its fighters overran parts of Iraq. The symbol ("n" for "Nazarene") marked the buildings belonging to Christians and also served as a threat: They could convert to Islam, leave the area or be killed. Hundreds of thousands of Christians fled, but where are they today? In the "I am N" event you'll hear updates from Iraq and firsthand accounts from three faithful Christians who willingly risk their lives to proclaim the gospel in regions dominated by Islam. These are not just stories of survival; they're testimonies of God's faithfulness to us amid trials, as he continues to use these bold believers to advance his kingdom.
