Results of the Elders' Pastoral Recommendation Vote The elders would like to thank you for participating in calling Pastor Jeff to another 5 year term. 98 ballots were cast: 89 voted yes, 9 voted no. With a 91% affirmation, Pastor Jeff will continue in his role here at PVMC, new term ending August 31st of 2030.
