**Results of the Wider Church Affiliation's Vote** This vote narrowed PVMC's wider church affiliation options from 3 to 2. 85 ballots were cast with the Fellowship of Evangelical Churches (FEC) receiving 65 votes, LMC (formerly known as Lancaster Mennonite Conference) receiving 62 votes and Mennonite Brethren receiving 38 votes. The date for the next vote to choose between FEC and LMC has not yet been set. To learn more about these two organizations please go to their websites.
