The annual meeting is set for Sunday, January 25th. A list of committees with terms ending in 2025 and are open for nomination has been posted to the bulletin board in the foyer. The elders have received the 2026 budgetary needs for the committees and have met with the treasurer to assess available funds for the 2026 budget. Thanks to your generous giving, the elders are recommending a budget of \$474,743.26. The budget breakdown is as follows: Elders: \$130,100; CEC: \$23,000; SALT: \$20,000; Trustees: \$143,310.33; and Missions: \$158,332.93.
