Results of the Wider Church Affiliation Vote Sunday, February 1st, 93 ballots were cast resulting in 47 votes for Fellowship of Evangelical Churches (FEC) and 46 votes for LMC (formerly Lancaster Mennonite Conference). To take action, a two-thirds majority is required by PVMC's constitution. The elders want to thank everyone who participated in the vote and invite the congregation to continue to pray for unity and clarity in the discernment of our wider church affiliation. PVMC is currently a provisional member of LMC through South Central District until the end of June.
